Students will learn relevant vocabulary and discuss healthy lifestyle choices. This topic promotes awareness of personal well-being and encourages students to share their experiences and perspectives.

8-mavzu. Analyzing Reading Materials

Literary Devices: Pay attention to metaphors, similes, symbolism, and other devices that enhance meaning.

9-mavzu. Travel and Adventure

To discuss the significance of travel, different travel experiences, and the impact of tourism on local cultures and economies. Students will share their travel stories, learn about travel vocabulary, and explore different destinations. This

topic fosters speaking skills and cultural awareness while encouraging students to express their aspirations for future travel.

10-mavzu. Analyzing Reading Materials

Context: Consider the historical or cultural context in which the work was written and how it influences the content.
