

REPORT

on the work carried out by the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies in 2023

According to the action plan of the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies, preventive measures and roundtable discussions on avoiding and fighting corruption were held among university staff, professors and students. The following were organized:

- 12 roundtable discussions;
- 2 seminars;
- 6 meetings.

968 students and 82 professors of the university took part in these events.

Monitoring of the work done on placement of students in student residences was carried out in cooperation with the vice-rector for youth issues and spiritual and educational affairs of the university.

In order to prevent conflicts of interest and corruption offenses, the department is constantly monitoring the orders and other regulatory documents adopted by the university.

The university has a telegram bot @tsuosanticorruptionbot and the phone number (99871) 232-16-76 is set by the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies to prevent and fight against corruption in the university, to ensure openness and transparency. In addition, appeals received through the Telegram bot and hotline are being studied in the prescribed manner. Work in this direction is ongoing.

Surveys are being conducted among students based on the plan to study the opinions of students on the state of corruption in the university by the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control, approved by the rector of the university on December 5, 2023. A system of collegial discussion of survey results has been established.

According to it, the implementation of the necessary measures to eliminate the identified negative situations is determined.

According to the order of the rector of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies dated June 1, 2023, №113, the statutes of the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control and the Anti-Corruption Student Club on fighting against corruption are approved. The Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control of the university is operating, as well as, the activity of the Anti-Corruption Student Club has been established on the basis of this statute. Students who can ensure the rule, are patriotic, selfless in the fight against corruption, enthusiastic and have exemplary morals are being recruited into the club membership.

The following activities were carried out at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies in connection with the December 9 “International Anti-Corruption Day”:

On November 6 and December 11, 12, 2023, a roundtable discussion on the topic “Let’s fight against corruption together” was organized with the participation of 320 students and the staff of the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control.

On November 17, 2023, the staff of the Department of Management System of Combating Corruption Compliance-Control organized open classes on the topic “Corruption is an obstacle to our development”, in which 115 students participated.

On November 20, 2023, a day event “Open Doors” dedicated to issues such as ensuring the openness of the university’s activities, preventing and eliminating corruption risks was held at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies. 27 professors, 45 students, 7 mass media and 5 other public representatives took part in this event.

This event was broadcast on November 21, 2023, in the program “Davr” of the TV channel “Yoshlar” and the information program “Poytaxt” of the TV channel “Toshkent”, and on the website of “Kun.uz” on November 22. It was also published in the November 21 issue of “Yangi O‘zbekiston” newspaper. It was also announced on the website of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies and the Telegram social page. Public activists Nuriddin Ziyo Turaqulov and Muzaffar Muhammedjanov’s Facebook page also covered it.

Members of the Council of the Youth Union of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies and students expressed their views through a flash mob under the slogan “Corruption is a threat to our future” within the framework of “Anti-Corruption Month” in connection with December 9 - the International Anti-Corruption Day.
