Each article will be checked for plagiarism through turnitin.com system.

After approval of the article, authors should make a contribution of 100 thousand UZS to cover expenses of indexing in scientific and technical databases, with the attachment of DOI number.

Selected articles will be included in the publication of the Proceedings of the International Conference.

Published articles will be indexed in the following databases:

Each article published in the Proceedings will be assigned a DOI (Crossref) number.

Requirements for the article:

The volume of the article should not be less than 7-10 pages.

The text of the article in Times New Roman font, size 14, in doc format, with an interval of 1.5, on the right side - 15 mm, on the left - 30 mm, 20 mm at the top and bottom.

Requirements for the structure of the article:

- ✓ the title of the article should be given in capital letters;
- ✓ author's last name, first name, position, academic title, place of work, e-mail address and phone number;
- ✓ abstract (brief content and purpose of the article, not less than 100 words) should be given in the Uzbek, Russian, English, Turkish languages;
- ✓ key words and phrases should consist of 7-10 words;
- the content of the article should consist of Introduction, Main part, Results and Discussions, Conclusions, List of References. Footnotes are given at the end of the article. Footnotes are organized in the following form [e.g., 1, p.23].
