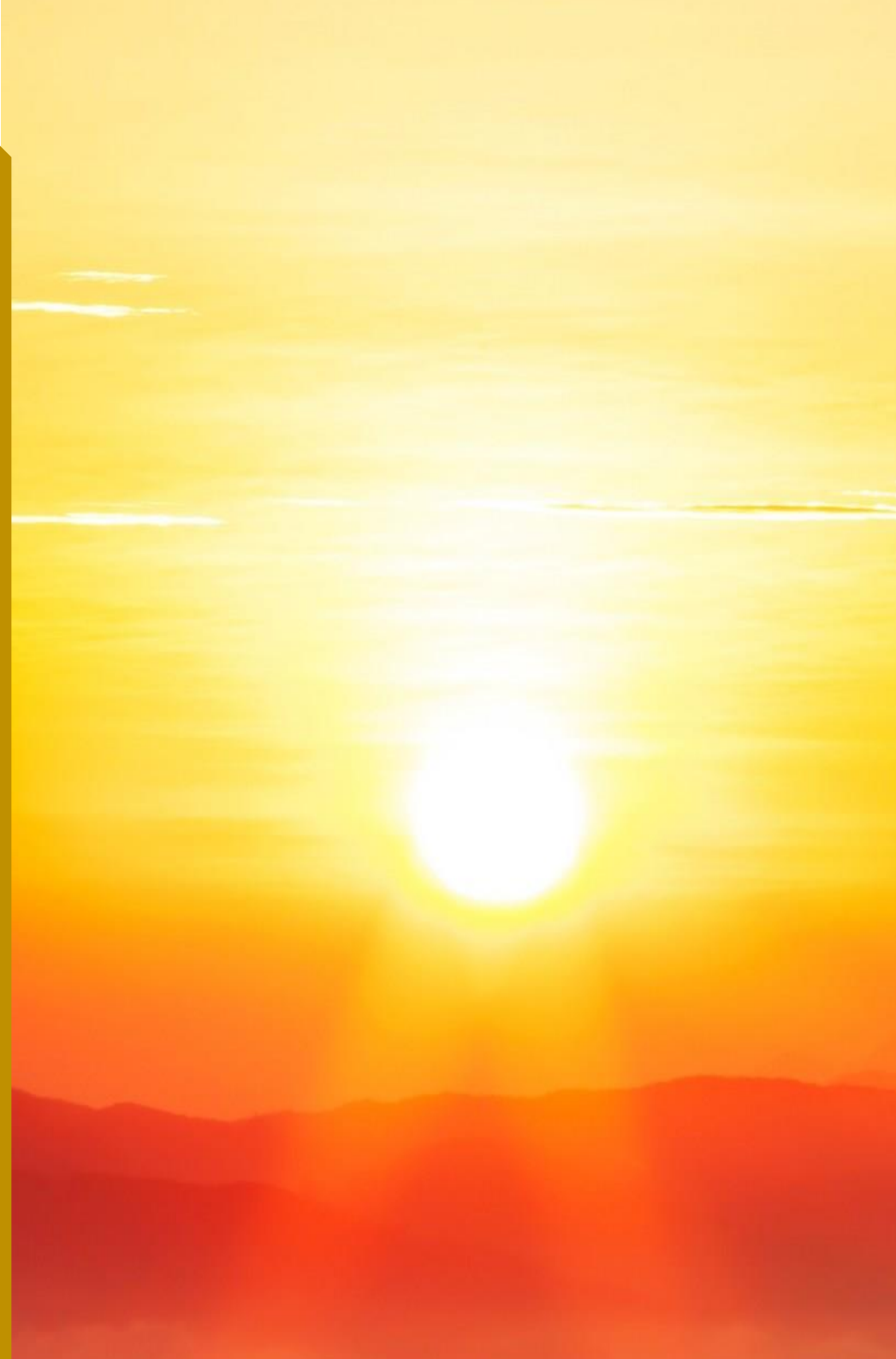
ANNUAL REPORT 2022/23

ABOUT TASHKENT STATE UNIVERSITY OF ORIENTAL STUDIES

Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS) was founded in 1918, making it one of the most historical and unique universities in Central Asia. TSUOS prepares specialists in oriental studies, linguistics, history, literature, political science, economics, tourism, etc. There are 7 faculties and 27 academic departments at TSUOS. Additionally, students can study 14 bachelor's, and 15 master's specializations, and 10 doctoral research areas within the university.

WHAT IS OUR GOAL?

TSUOS is a multidisciplinary educational institution specializing in further strengthening and developing the existing potential of the country in the field of Oriental Studies and training modern orientalists to meet the need for personnel who can interpret simultaneously and analyze the socio-political processes. Besides, helping further improve the quality of training personnel with comprehensive knowledge by international standards in the field of Oriental Studies, the rapid development of science, capacity building of teachers, continuous improvement of pedagogical skills, and the education of students based on oriental values are considered the main goals of the university.

This long-term objective is supported by sustainable development, which puts structures and mechanisms in place and receives backing from international, national, and local organizations.

Sustainable Development Goals 1

1 NO POVERTY



In the 2022-2023 academic year, TSUOS carried out a number of activities within the framework of the 1st goal of the SDG, "No poverty". These include special scholarships for female students, assistance in the implementation of various start-up projects, motivational meetings, etc. All of this has an impact on students' education and future work as specialists in their field. Below is the work done within this goal.

A total of 22 scholarship holders in the 2022-2023 academic year

"Special scholarship named after Suyima Ganieva" was established at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies to support talented women in higher educational institutions.

COMPETITIONS

Two students of TSUOS won the Malaysian Prime Minister's Cup "The Bahasa Melayu International Speaking Competition", which was held in Malaysia, and took a trophy with cash RM 18 000 in total.

Ruka Watanabe (from Japan), a student at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies took first place in a republican competition "Uzbek language – translator of my heart", and awarded UZS 13,2 million.

On the occasion of the Constitution Day of the Republic of Uzbekistan, a competition of scientific articles and an olympiad on the study of the rules and principles of the Constitution was held at TSUOS. The first three winners were awarded UZS 2,4 million in total.

As part of the "Orientalist Students' Festival", the intellectual game ERUDITE-QUARTET was organized for the first time in our university. At the end of the festival, the winners were awarded cash prizes totalling UZS 4,5 million.

A student of TSUOS, Azamat Fayzullaev, took third place in the "Young Reader" competition and received a cash prize of UZS 30 million.

START-UPS AND EVENTS

There have been a large number of seminars and motivational meetings at TSUOS this academic year. The main aim is to support young students' start-up projects

As part of the "Ideaton - Uzbekistan 2030" competition, projects such as "Halal eating", "Dictionary of terms related to the field of tourism in Eastern languages (in Chinese, Japanese, Turkish, Arabic, Persian, Hindi, Urdu)" Online indoor map", "Save nature" were presented.

A master class was held with the participation of Bekzod Mirakhmedov, one of the highest IELTS 9.0 scorers in our country and holder of the CELTA international certificate, for talented students of the university who were about to start their start-up project.

A spiritual and educational event entitled "What should a student of the 21st century be like?" was organized at TSUOS. The executive director of "Silk Road Research Academy" Dr. Azamat Akbarov visited the event as a lecturer. He shared his years of experience with the students gathered at the event.

Two members of the joint-stock company "Uzbekistan Airways" held a motivational meeting for TSUOS students on how to get hired in the company, what procedures have to be undergone, etc.

A motivational meeting was held at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies as part of the incubation program "My Start-up Project".

The head of the "Orientalist Analysts" intellectual club, Doctor of Philosophy (PhD), Associate Professor S. Buronov held a master class for students on the topic "Rules of writing a scientific article in political sciences" at TSUOS. In the master class, he elaborated on issues such as in-depth analysis of the politics and international relations of Eastern countries, their scientific evaluation and in-depth study of the skills of writing a scientific article. In the future, students will use this information in their scientific articles and diploma theses.

The Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovations organized a seminar training for the heads of the department "Organization of Scientific and Research Activities of Gifted Students" of all higher education institutions. Laziz Turaev, the head of the department "Organization of research activities of gifted students" of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies, took an active part in this training. At the seminar, Akbarkhan Sobirkhanov, the head of the Department of Coordination of the Youth Academy, and D. Nuriddinov, the department employee, gave information about the activities of the Youth Academy, and various competitions held by the academy for students and researchers. During the training, the participants received necessary information on organizing the activities of the academy, working with leaders, and other related issues. At the end of the day, a tour was organized at INNO Techno Park.

VOLUNTEERING

In 2023, 801 teachers, students and doctoral students of TSUOS participated as volunteer interpreters in 13 international events.

The awarding ceremony of the global award "For outstanding achievements in the fight against corruption", established by the initiative of the Emir of Qatar, was held in Tashkent in December 2023. Students from TSUOS were selected as volunteers at this ceremony and they accompanied a number of Arab officials as interpreters. After the ceremony, monetary awards were presented to all students who translated on behalf of TSUOS.

In the III International Kickboxing Tournament "Uzbekistan Open", 9 students of TSUOS participated as volunteer interpreters in different languages. Such voluntary work will have a positive effect on students' future lives and help them gain international experience and establish international networking. After the international tournament, the university awarded all the volunteers with certificates of honor and cash prizes.

A student of TSUOS participated as a volunteer interpreter in the "Education USA South and Central Asia Regional" forum organized at the Intercontinental Hotel. In the framework of the largest forum of the US Embassy in Central Asia, the student worked as a volunteer interpreter for delegations from India and Kazakhstan and further increased her experience. Such volunteering programs not only keep students up to date with field news but also encourage them to improve their language skills and earn money in their sphere in the future.

TRAINING

Students of the Faculty of Oriental Philology and Translation Studies of TSUOS, Khudoyorova Iroda, Kayumova Sabrina, Abdullaeva Zebuniso, Turgunova Nigina and Azamatov Avazbek interned 7 months between September 20, 2022, and May 1, 2023, at Kendriya Hindi Sansthan Institute in Agra, India. In the course of the study, the articles of our students were published in the "World of Hindi" magazine. They also participated in a number of national dance competitions and won the 1st place.

FESTIVALS

On October 7, 2023, the Golden Autumn season and the Chusok holiday were held with great enthusiasm together with professors and teachers of the Department of Korean Philology and students of all majors studying the Korean language. On December 6, 2023, the department held a charity campaign of Uzbek and Korean cuisine under the slogan "Every child is loved and cared for". The proceeds from the campaign were presented to an orphanage.



CHARITY WORKS

Youth Union Primary Organization and Departments of TSUOS regularly organize visits to orphanages. Children there are given different gifts, clothes, and food. Below are some of them.

Within the framework of the UN Sustainable Development Goals 2, "Zero hunger", students of the Faculty of Korean Studies visited the orphanage No. 30 in Tashkent. During the visit, the students played interesting games together with the foster children of the orphanage. After the visit, various school supplies, food, toys and gifts were distributed to the children.

On September 21, 2023, members of TSUOS Youth Union Primary Organization, faculty coordinators, and active students organized the charity event "Merciful Heart" at the 30th charity house in Tashkent within the framework of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals 2, i.e. Zero Hunger. During the project, students together with children of the orphanage conducted entertainment programs and games with prizes. At the end of the event, educational materials, books, toys, and sweets were given to the children.

On December 18, 2023, professors and teachers of the Department of Korean Philology visited orphanage No. 30. During the visit, professors and teachers got acquainted with the interests of orphans and the activities of clubs. Although the institution is fully funded by the state, attention to orphans is very valuable and important. At the end of the visit, New Year's gifts were distributed to the orphans.

The books "Grammatical Categories in Arabic and English" and poetry "Alfath" by TSUOS students, Shahobiddin Yoldashev, Hamidova Gulnoza and Abdusalomova Khurshida, were published on Amazon.com in the United States of America. In addition, an article entitled "How to effectively teach young children?" by a 2nd-year student of Arabic philology, Hamraeva Robiyabonu, was published in the international magazine "Page 3 News", which is printed in the USA, Canada and Thailand. Such publishing activities of students will help them earn money in their field in the future.

DIPLOMA WORK

On June 7, 2023, Shakhnazarova Sevara, a student of the "Economy of the Eastern Countries" department, presented the results of the research conducted within the framework of her diploma work on ensuring food security in Egypt on the topic "Features of cooperation between the Arab Republic of Egypt and the UN in ensuring food security".

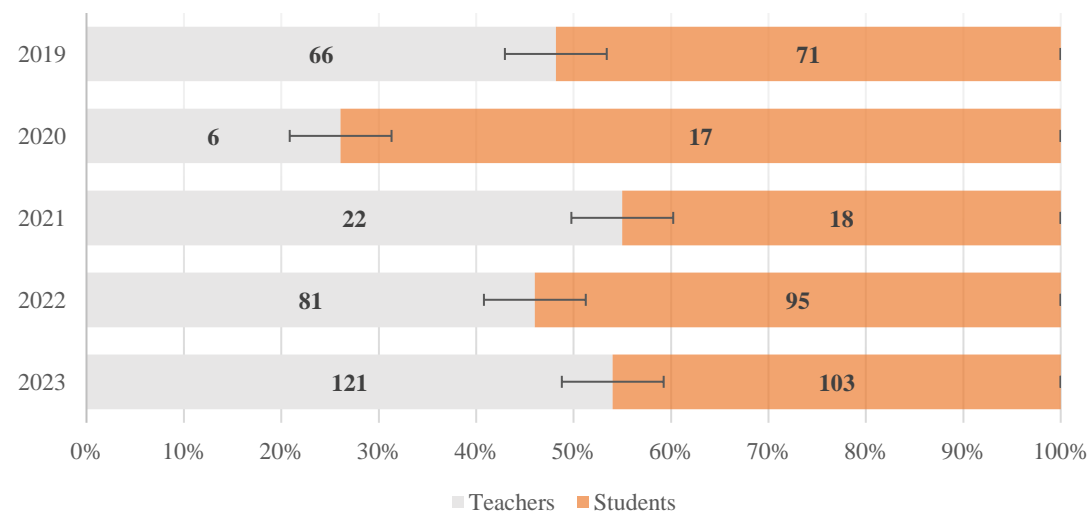
EVENTS DEDICATED TO EDUCATION

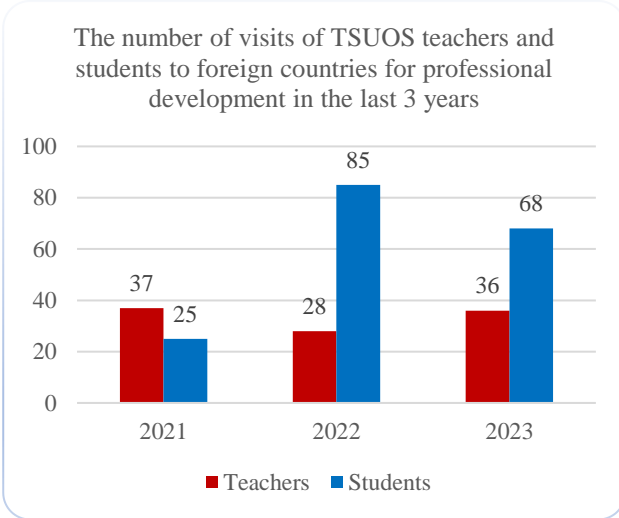

On November 23, Professor U. Muhibova gave a lecture on "Bhakti literature of the Babur period" for the master's and doctoral students of Jawaharlal Nehru University.

Associate Professor D. Muhiddinova and Professor P. Kenjaeva gave several lectures to the students of the literature of this university on comparing the narrative of modern Uzbek, Turkish and Arabic within the framework of the visit.

On November 2, 2023, D. Abbasova, an Associate Professor of the "Korean Philology" Department, hosted an online theoretical seminar on the topic of the comparative research of compound sentences in Korean and Uzbek languages in one of the partner universities of TSUOS – Keimyung University.

The Rector of TSUOS and Ph.D., Associate Professor F.M. Khasanova gave lectures entitled "Uzbekistan and China: Cooperation in Higher Education and Scientific Field" and "Uzbekistan-China: a Common Perspective in Cultural Relations and Education" at the conference "China-Central Asia and Asia-Pacific Region: Development and Cooperation".

Associate Professor N. Khodjaeva participated online in the first international conference "CTPD CON-ERA 2023 Education Reforms and Achievements" in the framework of the UN's SDG 4, which was held by the Council for Teachers Professional Development (CTPD) in Delhi.

On October 16, 2023, within the framework of the week of innovative ideas, foreign teacher Muhammad Ramzan Ali gave a lecture on the topic "Ways to develop creative education in Uzbekistan".

On the same day, a seminar – training under the slogan "Creative education and innovation based on the development of New Uzbekistan" was also held at the Faculty of Oriental Philology and Translation Studies. Doctoral student Oybek Jumaboev conducted a seminar on "Organization of synchronous translation activities" and shared his knowledge of important aspects of synchronous translation with those gathered.

A scientific and practical conference on "Teaching foreign languages in the context of Sustainable Development: Advanced Technologies, problems and opportunities" was held by the Department of "Western Languages" of TSUOS. A number of professors from Canada, India, Egypt and Spain took part at this conference.

On March 30, 2023, the Department of "Oriental Literature and Comparative Literary Studies" held a traditional conference of talented master's and bachelor's students on the topic "Literature of the peoples of the East: Today and Tomorrow" in order to involve them to scientific research.

A group of professors, teachers, and researchers of the Faculty of Korean Studies participated in the 11th International Central Asian Conference "Changing Central Asia and the New Paradigm of Korean Studies" in June in Astana, Republic of Kazakhstan, and the "21st International Conference of Korean Language Specialists" held in July in Incheon, South Korea. From May 30 to June 2, 2023, lectures and seminars for professors and students were organized at TSUOS by Professor E. Paskaleva of Leiden University, the Netherlands within the framework of the Erasmus+ ICM program.

In February 2023, Professor, Doctor of Philology of Gazi University Fatma Acik, and Nurullah Chetin, Professor, and Doctor of Philology at Ankara University, held online theoretical seminars on the topics "The Image of Amir Temur in Turkish and Uzbek Novels" and "Currents in the era of national literature" at the Department of Oriental Literature and Comparative Literary Studies of TSUOS. Emek Ushenmez, Associate Professor and Doctor of Philology at Istanbul University, also delivered open lectures entitled "Views on the miniatures of Alisher Navoi's works in the British Library" and "Oybek's work during the Second World War".

On March 10, 2023, a webinar was organized by Vali Savash Yelok, Doctor of Philological Sciences, Associate Professor of Ankara Hacı Bayram Veli University, Türkiye, on the topic "Uzbek and Turkish literary relations".

All of these online webinars and seminars were organized within the framework of Literary Studies Month.

On May 14-29, 2023, an intern-teacher of the Department of "Translation Studies and International Journalism" of TSUOS, Kurolova Sayyora, participated in the English-Chinese International Language Conference "Seminar on Chinese Language and Culture for Developing Countries" with her lecture in the People's Republic of China.

On May 19, 2023, the Faculty of Oriental Civilization and History held the traditional VI scientific-practical conference of master's and bachelor's students on the topic "Development features of Eastern countries: history, anthropology and philosophy". Students conducting research in the fields of history, anthropology and philosophy took part in the conference with their speeches.

On December 14, 2023, the International Scientific and Practical Conference "Translation Forum – 2023" was held at TSUOS. The Rector of TSUOS, the Chairman of the Union of Writers of Uzbekistan Sirojiddin Sayyid, and Associate Professor of TOBB ETU Tashkent Nurgul Bekar attended at this conference.



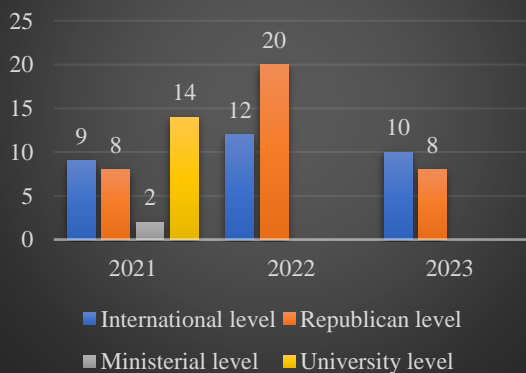
On September 15, 2023, a republican scientific-practical seminar on "Creating methodical manuals, dictionaries, scientific and theoretical literature on the problems of in-depth teaching of the Uzbek language" was held at the Center for Training and Professional Development of the basics of working in the State language at Alisher Navoi Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature. The Rector of TSUOS Professor G.Rikhsieva gave a lecture on "Methodology of teaching the Uzbek language to foreign students" and Professor Sh.Usmonova on "Linguistic and cultural aspects of teaching the Uzbek language to foreign students".

RETRAINING COURSE LECTURES AND DISCUSSIONS

In 2022, a total of 28, and in 2023, 36 teachers were sent abroad for retraining courses.

In 2023, a number of professors and teachers of TSUOS, Dilorom Saidoripova, Saida Sultankhojaeva, Saodat Umarova, and Aziza Nishanbaeva, improved their skills for two weeks virtually and went to Tehran and other partner universities and institutions on June 4-17. During their training, they met professors and teachers at the Department of International Relations, Tehran University, and studied at Allameh Tabataba'i University, the Saadi Foundations, and the Academy of Persian Language and Literature. Such works will greatly help in the development of academic and cultural relations between the two universities, as well as in the improvement of the quality of education.

On January 6, 2023, Senior teachers of the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology S.Kamalova, R.Khaydarova, D.Botirova held a training and lectured on the topic "Psychological features of working with students" at the Faculty of Oriental Philology and Translation Studies at TSUOS.

On March 25, 2023, TSUOS hosted a roundtable discussion "Model of UN" dedicated to the analysis of Middle East problems. L.Turaev, the head of the department of scientific research organization of gifted students, and K. Khaqberdiev, the director of the research and analysis center for researching the development of Eastern countries, participated in the roundtable discussion. During the discussion, the student delegates expressed their views on the issues of international security, humanitarian cooperation, as well as transport and logistics corridors in Afghanistan.

In order to organize education outreach activities beyond campus in the direction of "SDG 4: Quality education", 2 professors of TSUOS visited the city of St. Petersburg, Russian Federation. The special topic of the first lecture was "Usin – the concept of the five elements in Chinese linguistics". The special topic of the 2nd lecture was "Features of noun formation in Chinese".

In December 2023, the Faculty of Korean Studies started organizing a series of online lectures on the topic of "Intercultural Communication" with Kyungdong University (KDU). Within the framework of the topic, the Dean of the Faculty of Korean Studies, Professor Usmanova Shoiras lecture entitled "Nonverbal Communication in Intercultural Communication", and Associate Professor of the Department of Chinese Philology, Ph.D. Shokhistakhon Shamsieva's lecture on "The use of euphemisms in intercultural communication" was held at KDU on ZOOM.

Professor of the Department of Classical Philology and Literary Source Studies, Doctor of Philology, "Honored Youth Trainer in the Republic of Uzbekistan", Kasimjon Sadikov gave a lecture entitled "Chagatai Literature and its Role in the History of Turkic Written Literature" to Hungarian students within the framework of MoU with Eötvös Loránd University.

A series of lectures by professors, Dr. Sabariah Sulaiman, Haddi Junaidi Kusnin, and Noorazalina Buang, were delivered in collaboration with TSUOS and Sultan Idris Education University (UPSI), Malaysia in October and November 2023. These lectures were organized to improve the academic level of professors, the quality of education, and exchange experiences between the universities.

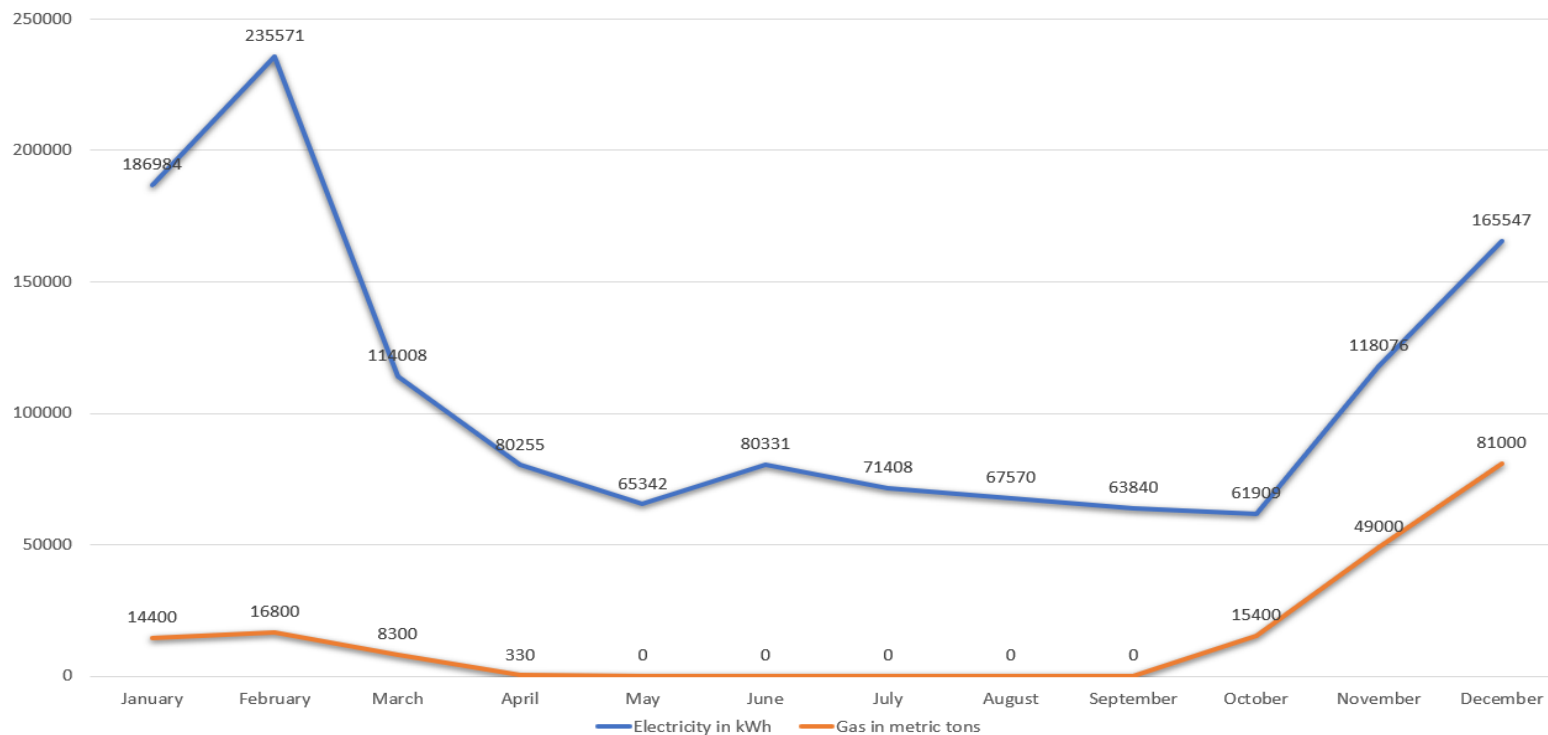
7 AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY



The installation of 760 kWh solar panels has been approved based on the solar panel installation program at the university. The measures to include these panels in the "Green Energy" platform of the Customs Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan and to connect them to the networks of the Joint Stock Company "Regional Electric Networks" were completed on September 28, 2023. The work in this regard is carried out to prevent pollution of the environment, to create a stable ecological environment, and to ensure a healthy and prosperous life.

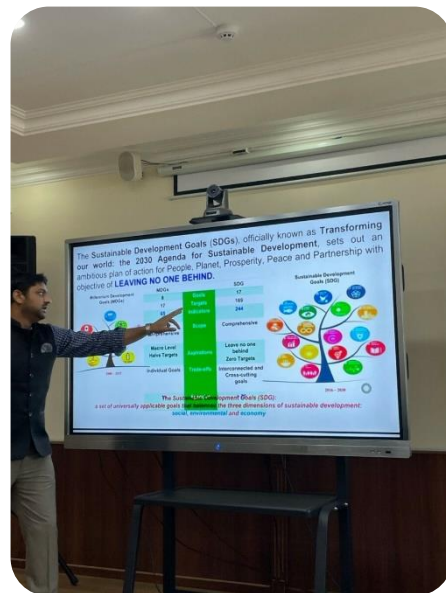


LECTURES

In 2023, funds of 47 309 000 UZS were allocated to send the children of 17 teachers and staff to the "West Camp".

In order to implement state programs, meaningful and interesting meetings, cultural and educational events were organized among workers and young people with the involvement of well-known figures of science, literature and art, literary experts, and industrial pioneers. Such events have a positive effect on the morale of staff and motivate them to work with special enthusiasm in their work in the future.

Based on the conditions stipulated in the "Collective agreement" and in order to provide comprehensive support to teachers-professors, the following monetary awards were given in 2023 at the expense of extra-budgetary funds of the university:

- 189 750 000 UZS for 330 staff on the occasion of "International Women's Day" on March 8;
- 319 125 000 UZS for 555 teachers-professors on the occasion of "Teacher's Day" on October 1;
- at the end of the academic year 2022-2023, 1 577 443 000 UZS for 268 professors and teachers with high-performance indicators, and students who won in competitions at Tashkent city, and republican levels.

In 2023, additional funds in the amount of 6 646 394 846 UZS were allocated to the salaries of 320 university professors, management and staff. Funds in the amount of 347 082 920 UZS were given as a financial incentive to 419 university students who achieved high results during the 2022-2023 academic year, won in university, city, and republican competitions, and participated in public affairs.



The following were carried out within the "Payment of labor: Guaranteed payments and compensation payments" of the "Collective agreement":

1. In accordance with Clause 61, payment of salaries in accordance with the procedure established by the laws and legal documents of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
2. Terms of payment of salaries in accordance with Clause 62:
For the first half of the month - until the 18th of the month;
For the second half of the month - pay by the 5th of the following month.

Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies pays special attention to students with disabilities and those, who are in need of social protection. The same conditions and opportunities are provided for their movement on the campus as for all students. The Trade Union Committee and the Youth Union support the disabled and provide them with various services. Special places are reserved for them in the student dormitories, as well as special terms of use of the university library, books in Braille are available. Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies, as an organization, pursues an anti-discrimination and persecution policy. The basic principles of the policy are reflected in the university's code of ethics.

DECREES

According to the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to fundamentally improve the system of state support for applicants with disabilities" dated December 1, 2017 №5270, it is established to introduce the procedure of allocating an additional two percent state grant for the admission of individuals to higher education institutions. In accordance with the implementation of this decree, TSUOS admits students for an additional two percent state grant quotas.

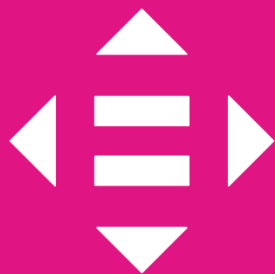
In the entrance exams in accordance with the "Regulation on the procedure for admitting persons with disabilities to higher education institutions on the basis of additional state grant quotas" approved by the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers №417 dated June 2, 2018, applicants with disabilities (I and II groups) who have scored not less than 30% of the highest possible score are admitted within the additional two percent state grant quotas. At TSUOS, 46 students with disabilities are studying with full use of all services and opportunities.

Ensuring the implementation of the Decrees of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan №209 of April 18, 2022, №57 of December 21, 2021, as well as №407 of October 20, 2022, and establishing inclusive education and the necessary conditions for them, the practical project "Creating a mobile learning application in history for blind and visually impaired students studying in higher education institutions" at TSUOS has been completed.

On December 7, 2022, the Decree of the Rector of TSUOS №386 on allocating subsidies to orphans and those who are deprived of parental care from the state budget once a year for the purpose of purchasing educational scientific and literature books, was issued. According to this decree, subsidies were allocated to the relevant students.

FINANCIAL AID

7 orphans, 46 students with disabilities, 67 underrepresented students studied at TSUOS in the academic year 2021/22. Since 2022, the university has awarded prizes to winners of national and international competitions, active participants in various spiritual and educational events, as well as students who are in need of social protection, who have lost their breadwinners, and financial aid has been allocated to those who lived in rented accommodation.

These are the following:

Funds in the amount of 33 600 000 UZS were allocated for the autumn festival of TSUOS students



666 800 000 UZS were spent on work with youth and spiritual and educational activities



148 883 894 UZS of financial assistance was provided for those in need of social protection



Total monthly rent of 104 100 000 UZS for 347 students living in rented accommodation were paid



Funds in the amount of 40 600 000 UZS were allocated for the festival of oriental studies students.



Tuition fees of 52 women, people from socially needy families, orphans, or those deprived of parental care, admitted on a fee basis at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies and studying for a bachelor's degree were paid in cooperation with the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation.

In 2023, funds in the amount of 136 663 000 UZS were allocated to 56 professors and staff of the university went to sanatoriums and resorts in different regions of our republic at the expense of the trade union committee and social insurance funds, so that they and their family members could recover their health and have a rest.

Trade Union Committee provided financial support to those, in need of social protection, underprivileged and whose family is large, to ensure the implementation of its obligations regarding social benefits and guarantees. In 2023, according to the decision of the Presidium of the Trade Union Committee of the university, financial assistance in the amount of 62 100 000 UZS was allocated to 135 teachers and staff.



In 2023, as part of the provision of social protection and financial support, according to the decision and recommendation of the university trade union board, the amount of 339 090 000 UZS was allocated from extra-budgetary funds for 102 professors and teachers' wedding ceremonies and funerals, and for the recovery of their health and the purchase of medicines. In addition, financial assistance in the amount of 62 778 320 UZS was spent on 18 students due to difficult family conditions, the death of their parents, low income, disability and to pay tuition fees.

The following payments were made in accordance with the articles specified in Clause 9 of the "Collective Agreement" entitled "Social insurance: Social benefits and guarantees"

from 60 to 100 percent of the salary for employees registered for socially significant diseases

up to 50, 75 and 100 percent of the salary depending on the seniority of the employee at the university for temporary incapacity for work due to pregnancy and maternity leave

from 60 to 80 percent of the salary in other cases, depending on the total length of seniority of the employee

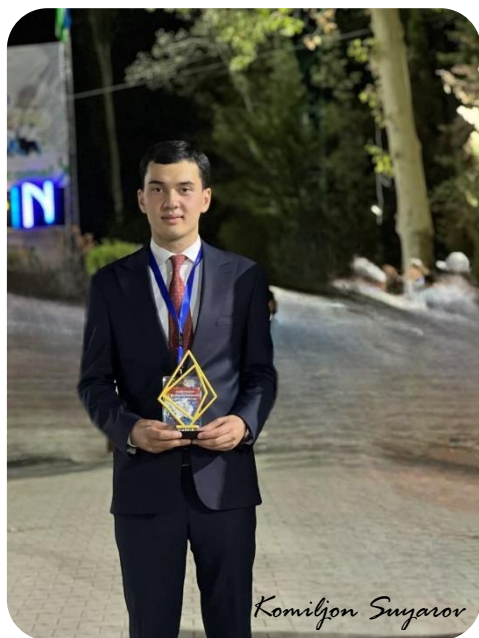
On October 23, 2023, K.Suyarov made a speech about elections and their democratic foundations to university community.

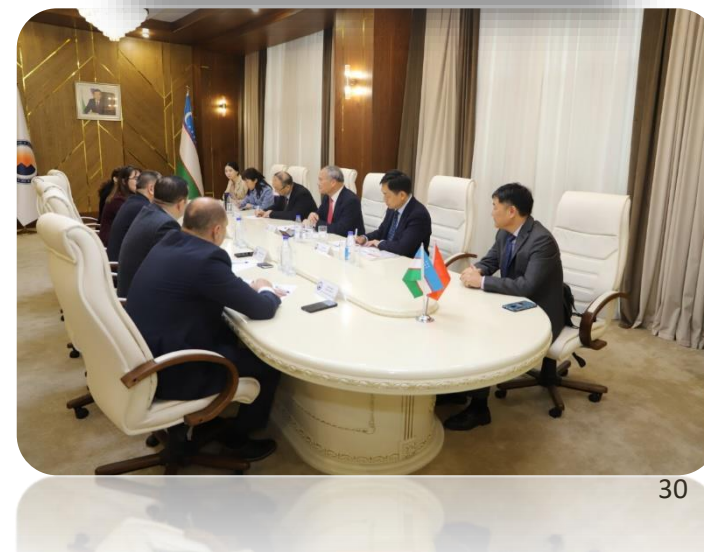
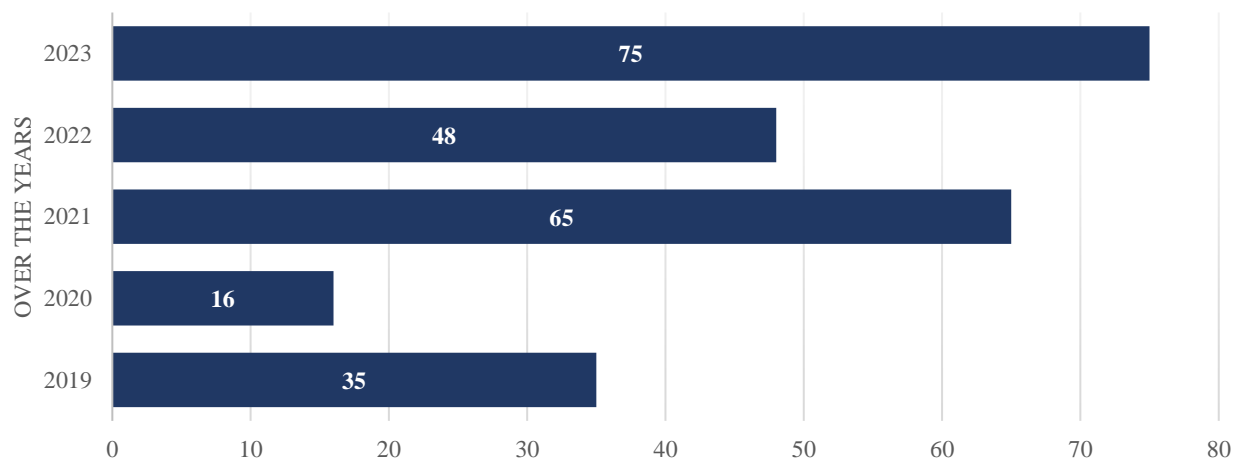

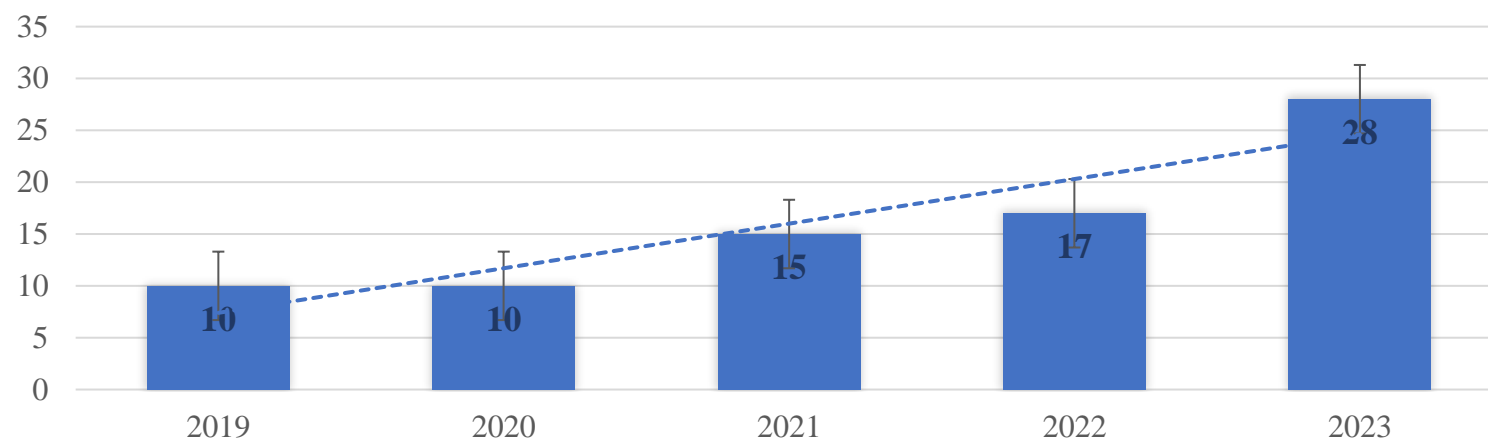

During the visit, Fariza Sham met with G.Rikhsieva, the Rector of TSUOS, and held negotiations on bilateral cooperation. After that, the opening ceremony of the "Center of the Malay language and culture" was held at TSUOS. Malaysian Islamic scholar Professor Fariza Sham held a scientific seminar for TSUOS students and young professionals.



On November 21, 2023, a delegation led by Du Yongjun, President of the UNESCO Organization of Gansu Province of the People's Republic of China visited TSUOS. During the meeting, future plans and issues of bilateral cooperation were discussed in cooperation between TSUOS and the Gansu UNESCO Organization.

EXAMPLES

The delegation of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies signed a cooperation agreement with the "ARABIC FOR ALL" organization in Saudi Arabia. This language center is engaged in the training of teachers of the Arabic language around the world. Cooperation with the center opens up many opportunities for TSUOS Arabists.



On September 14, 2023, a meeting was held at TSUOS with a delegation led by Duan Peng, President of Beijing Language and Culture University of the People's Republic of China. As a result of the negotiations, a memorandum of understanding was signed between Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies and Beijing University of Language and Culture on the creation of a research center "The Great Silk Road: Sinology and Translation Studies".
