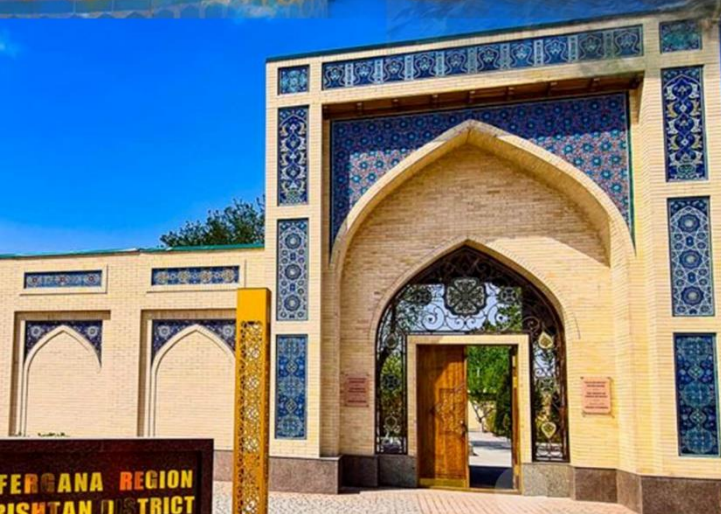

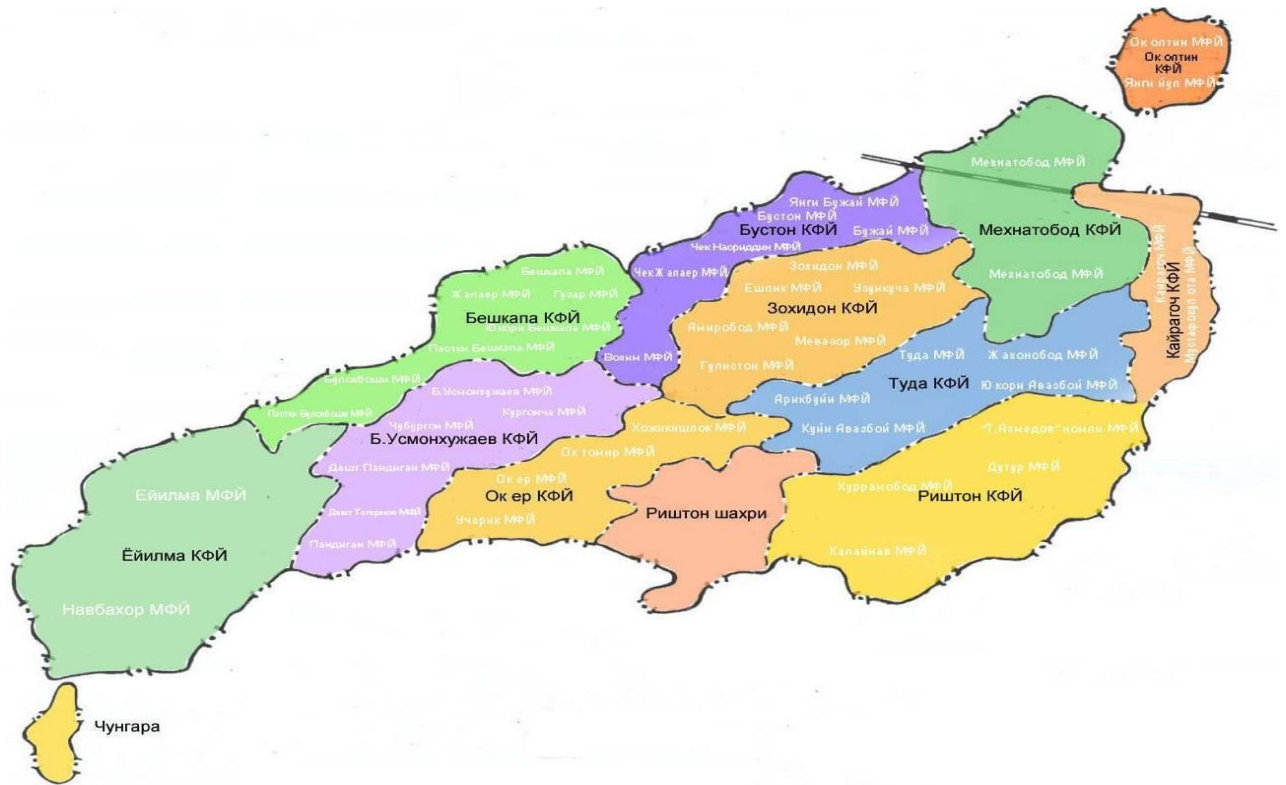

## INFORMATION ABOUT RISHTON DISTRICT

**Briefly about the district.** Rishton district is a district in Fergana region. It was founded on September 29, 1926. On March 7, 1959, it was merged with Sokh district. Sokh district was separated on February 27, 1990. It borders Baghdad to the north, Altariq to the southeast, Uzbekistan and Uchkoprik districts to the west, and Kyrgyzstan to the south. The area is 0.42.1 thousand km<sup>2</sup>. The population is 150.2 thousand people (2003). There is 1 city (Rishton) and several villages in the district (Chuburg'an, Uyrat, Pandigon, Temirmanboshi, Navbahor, Kipchak, Beshkapa, Buzrukhoja Usmonkhojaev, Bo'ston, Yoyilma, Zakhidon, Mehnatabad, Aqoltin, Oker, Rishton, Toda, Dutir, Qairaghoch) there is Its center is the city of Rishton.

**Tourist facilities.** The district has historical attractions such as the famous Khoja Ilgor Mosque, Khoja Ilgor Shrine, Yigitpirim Shrine, Qambarota Mosque, "Sahibi Hidaya" Shrine, Abdulazizkhanda Mausoleum, Abdulla Ansari Shrine, Khoja Roshnoyi Shrine.

### The population.

There are 2 music schools, 62 general education schools, 1 sports school, 2 vocational schools, 1 medical technical school named after Abu Ali Ibn Sina and a branch of the Kokan State Pedagogical Institute in Rishton district. Central library and its branches, culture house, culture and recreation park, 14 clubs, museums, central stadium, 4 hospitals, 2 polyclinics, 24 rural medical centers, 30 pharmacies, 233 doctors in sanatoriums and other medical institutions, 1,843 secondary medical workers works.

## TOURIST OBJECTS OF RISHTON DISTRICT

### 1. KHOJA ILGOR AND MULLA ISMATILLOH KORI PILGRIM

**Address:** Rishton district, Khoja Ilgor MFY

**Period:** XIX century

**Area:** 3000 sq.m

**Description:** Mulla Ismatilloh Qori Shrine is named after Mulla Ismatilloh Qori, who was born in 1888 in the Rishtan district to a farmer's family. Possessing deep religious knowledge, he even wrote a message of condolence in the Arabic alphabet with his own hands before his death. The mausoleums, the chillakhona cave are kept in good condition. Local and foreign tourists visit this neighborhood mainly to the shrine of "Khoja Ilgor and Mulla Ismatullah Qori".



**MFY passport:** 338 houses, 529 families and 1683 residents live in Khoja Ilgor neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 65 percent of the population is engaged in this field.

## 2. INTERNATIONAL POTTERY CENTER

**Address:** Rishton district, M. Topvoldiev MFY

**Period:** XXI century

**Description:** International Pottery Center Completed in 2020, this place has a pottery museum and pottery workshops. Local and foreign tourists visit these two places in this neighborhood.



**MFY passport:** 419 houses, 642 families and 2163 residents live in M. Topvoldiev neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 60 percent of the population is engaged in this field.



### 3. CRAFT CENTER

**Address:** Rishton district, Ak er MFY

**Period:** XXI century

**Description:** In the craft center There is a pottery museum and pottery workshops. Local and foreign tourists visit these two places in this neighborhood.



**Item Status:** construction works are underway

**MFY passport:** 519 households, 994 families and 2934 residents live in Ak Er neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is service, agriculture, and 45 percent of the population is engaged in service.

#### **4. "CORON-R" WORKSHOP AND MUSEUM, R. USMONOV'S WORKSHOP AND HOUSE MUSEUM**

**Address:** Rishton District, Center MFY

**Description:** In these places, there are workshops organized by famous potters in the field of pottery, as well as exhibitions of pottery products made by them, that is, museums. Local and foreign tourists visit these places to see pottery.



**MFY passport:** 421 houses, 629 families and 1985 residents live in Markaz neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 65 percent of the population is engaged in this field.



## 5. POTTERY WORKSHOP AND GUESTHOUSE OF ACADEMIC MASTER KULOL SHAROFIDDIN YUSUPOV

**Address:** Rishton district, Gumbaz MFY

**Description:** In this place, there is a workshop organized by the master potter Sharofiddin Yusupov, an exhibition of pottery products prepared by them, a museum, and a guest house. Local and foreign tourists visit this place precisely to see works in the field of ceramics.



**MFY passport:** 283 households, 320 families and 1104 residents live in Umbaz neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 45 percent of the population is engaged in this field.

## 6. CRAFT CENTER

**Address:** Rishton District, Qalaynav and Toraabad MFYs

**Description:** In each of these two neighborhoods, HConstruction of craft centers is underway. After the commissioning of these two facilities, the visit of local and foreign tourists to our district will increase and employment of the population will be ensured. In these places a pottery museum and pottery workshops are being built.

**Item Status:** construction works are underway



**MFY passport:** 734 houses, 998 families and 4033 residents live in Kalaynav neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is service, agriculture, and 45 percent of the population is engaged in pottery.

654 households, 1158 families and 4064 residents live in Toraabad neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is service, agriculture, and 60 percent of the population is engaged in pottery.



## 7. WORKSHOP AND MUSEUM OF “SAID & CERAMICS” FAMILY ENTERPRISE

**Address:** Rishton District, Qazi Ahror MFY

**Description:** In this place, there is a pottery workshop organized by Saidjon potter, as well as an exhibition of pottery products made by them, i.e. museums. Local and foreign tourists visit these places to see pottery.



**MFY passport:** 1014 households, 1374 families and 4657 residents live in Qazi Ahror neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 60 percent of the population is engaged in this field.

## 8. POTTERY WORKSHOP AND HOUSE MUSEUM ORGANIZED BY MASTER POTTER ALISHER NAZIROV

**Address:** Rishton District, Zar Arik MFY

**Description:** In this place, there is a pottery workshop organized by Alisher potter, as well as an exhibition of pottery products made by them, i.e. museums. Local and foreign tourists visit these places to see pottery.



**MFY passport:** There are 314 houses, 534 families and 2046 residents living in Zar Arik neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 52 percent of the population is engaged in this field.



## 9. TEA RESTAURANT AND HOTEL BELONGING TO “HALIMBOY+SALIMBOY” LLC

**Address:** Rishton District, Farovonlik MFY

**Description:** A modern hotel has been established in this place, where local and foreign guests stay, and a tea house is also established in this place. Local and foreign tourists visit these places to eat pilaf.



**MFY passport:** 236 houses, 360 families and 1144 residents live in Farovonlik neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is service and agriculture, and 70 percent of the population is engaged in these areas.

## 10. WORKSHOP AND MUSEUM OF "MINGBOSHI KERAMIK" FAMILY ENTERPRISE

**Address:** Rishton district, A. Navoi MFY

**Description:** In this place, there is a pottery workshop organized by Shakirjon potter and an exhibition of pottery products made by them, i.e. museums. Local and foreign tourists visit these places to see pottery.



**MFY passport:** 380 houses, 456 families and 1529 residents live in A.Navoi neighborhood. The main specialization of the neighborhood is pottery, and 75 percent of the population is engaged in this field.
