# ABOUT TASHKENT STATE UNIVERSITY OF ORIENTAL STUDIES

Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS) was founded in 1918, making it one of the most historic and unique universities in Central Asia. TSUOS prepares specialists in oriental studies, linguistics, history, literature, political science, economics, tourism, etc. There are 2 faculties, 2 institutes, 8 higher schools and 9 academic departments at TSUOS. Additionally, students can study 15 bachelor's, and 19 master's specializations, and 12 doctoral research areas within the university.

#### WHAT IS OUR GOAL?

TSUOS is a multidisciplinary educational institution specializing in further strengthening and developing the existing potential of the country in the field of Oriental Studies and training modern orientalists to meet the need for personnel who can interpret simultaneously and analyze the socio-political processes. Besides, helping further improve the quality of training personnel with comprehensive knowledge by international standards in the field of Oriental Studies, the rapid development of science, capacity building of teachers, continuous improvement of pedagogical skills, and the education of students based on oriental values are considered the main goals of the university.



This annual report on sustainable development mainly includes information on the activities carried out at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS) in the academic year 2024-2025. TSUOS operated in 4 goals according to Sustainable Development Goals 17 of the UN.

#### **EVENTS**

On March 19, 2024, the 3rd International Forum on the topic "Democracy: Universal Values" was held in Beijing, the capital of the People's Republic of China. The rector of SUOS, G. Rikhsieva, also participated in the event.

Obidov Asadbek, a student of the Political Science program at the Faculty of Turkology at TSUOS, participated in the Human Rights School organized by the Kazakhstan Youth Information Service in Shymkent, Kazakhstan, from March 18 to 23, 2024.

On March 27, 2024, the next meeting of the University Ethics Commission was held with the participation of the Rector of TSUOS G.Rikhsieva, vice-rectors, deans and the university inspector. At the meeting, the issues of compliance of professors, teachers, employees and with internal students rules, strengthening the spirit of patriotism, and systematically improving work related to the prevention of delinquency and crime at the university were discussed. In recent years, the growing geopolitical tension and the increasing subversive movements in different parts of the world have caused deep concern to the academics of our country. It is especially dangerous that young people, who are the most influential stratum of society, are influenced by the destructive ideas of certain groups.

Ibrohimjon Juraboev, a faculty member at TSUOS, and a graduate of the Master's program at Sapienza University of Rome (Italy), participated as an invited speaker at an international seminar on education governance held in Jiangxi Province, China.

On May 21, 2024, Shahnoza Farxodova, a master's student at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies, participated in the "Graduate and Youth Students" project organized by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, and Innovation in collaboration with Tashkent City Administration, securing an honorable position.

On June 9, 2024, Suhrob Buronov, a political scientist and lecturer at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS), gave an interview to UZA regarding Uzbekistan's role in ensuring peace, stability, and security in Central Asia. In the interview, he once again emphasized Uzbekistan's neutral approach in international politics and its commitment to strengthening regional cooperation.

Professor Sayfiddin Juraev and Associate Professor Nilufar Khodjaeva, Head of the Department at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS), were awarded the "People's Diplomat" badge by the SCO's Center for Public Diplomacy in Uzbekistan.

On September 23, 2024, students of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS), along with members of the "Young Orientalist Diplomats" and "Orientalist Analysts" clubs, participated in an open dialogue with a high-ranking official of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan, experienced diplomat Nurimbetov Rahmatilla.

On October 4, 2024, another round of debates was held as part of the election campaign. Representatives of various political parties expressed their views on pressing social issues, answered voters' questions, and commented on each other's positions.

During the debate, Dr. Sayfiddin Juraev, a professor of political science at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS), provided an in-depth analysis of the issues raised, responses given, and inter-party approaches.

On October 5, 2024, at the student dormitory of Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies, professors from the Department of Eastern Philosophy and Hermeneutics held roundtable discussion with students on the topic "Parliamentary Elections: Changes and Innovations in the Election Process".
