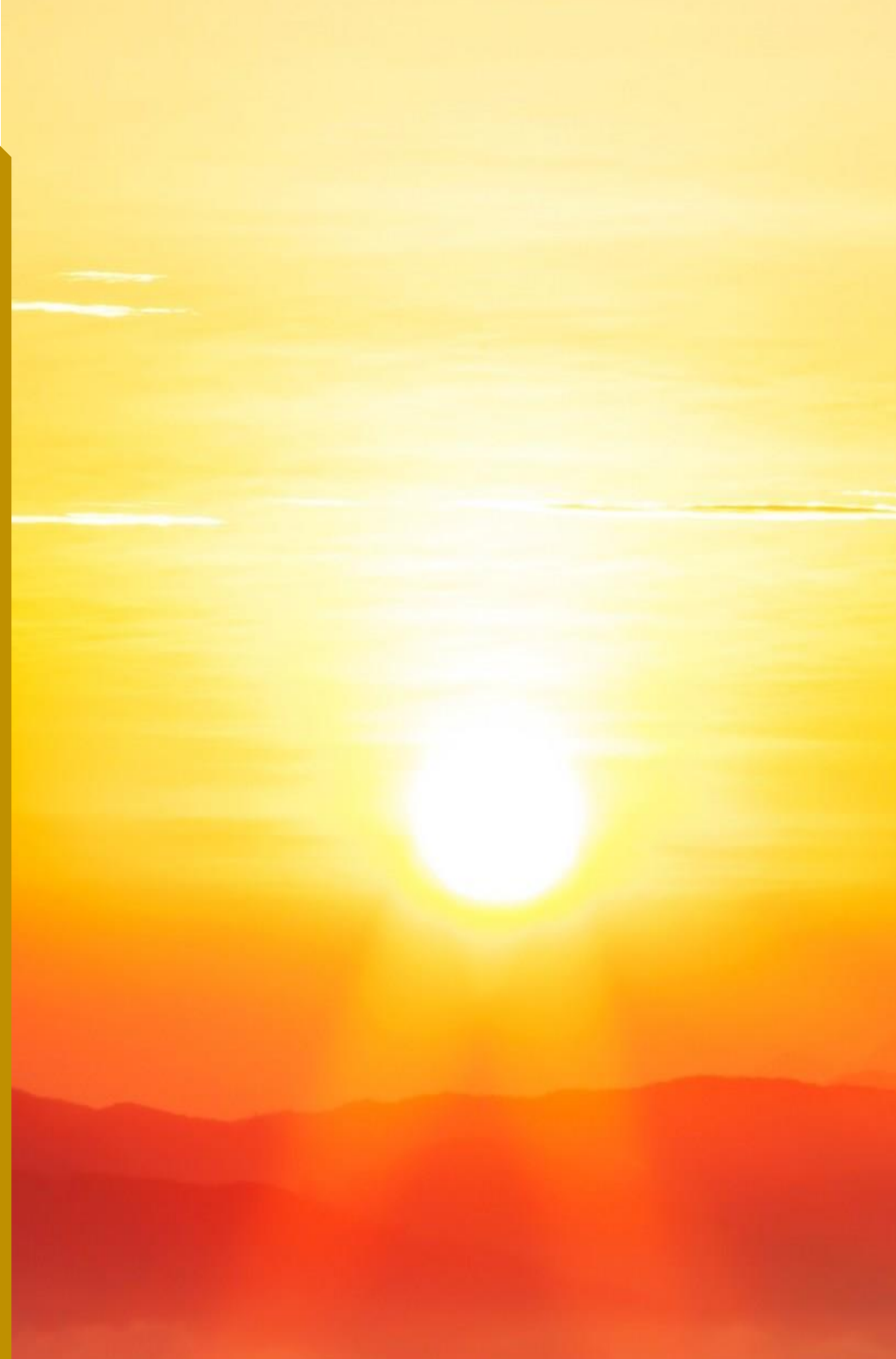

ABOUT TASHKENT STATE UNIVERSITY OF ORIENTAL STUDIES

Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies (TSUOS) was founded in 1918, making it one of the most historic and unique universities in Central Asia. TSUOS prepares specialists in oriental studies, linguistics, history, literature, political science, economics, tourism, etc. There are 2 faculties, 2 institutes, 8 higher schools and 9 academic departments at TSUOS. Additionally, students can study 15 bachelor's, and 19 master's specializations, and 12 doctoral research areas within the university.

WHAT IS OUR GOAL?

TSUOS is a multidisciplinary educational institution specializing in further strengthening and developing the existing potential of the country in the field of Oriental Studies and training modern orientalists to meet the need for personnel who can interpret simultaneously and analyze the socio-political processes. 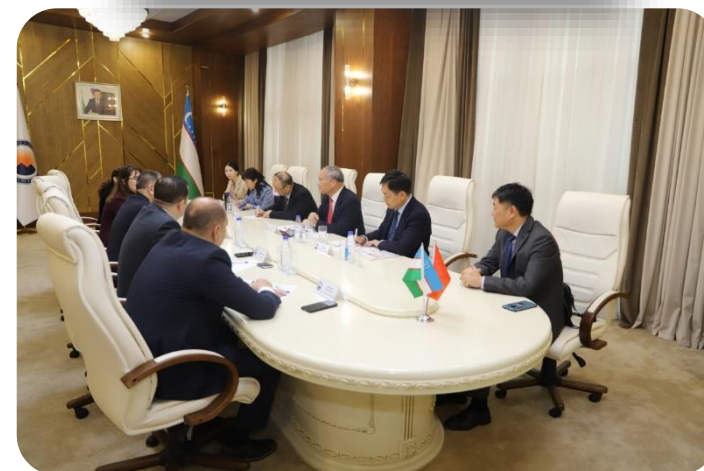
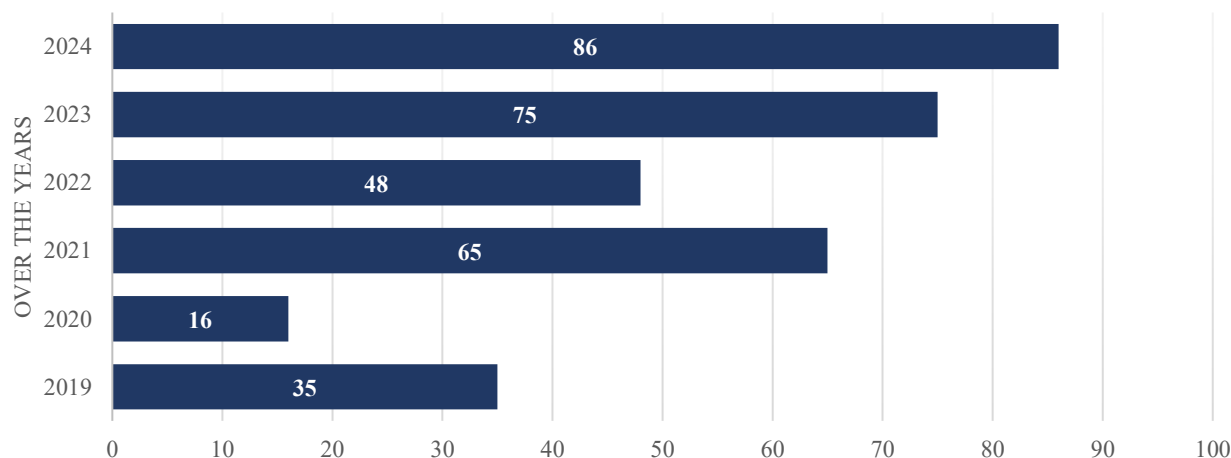

THE NUMBER OF DELEGATES VISITED TSUOS

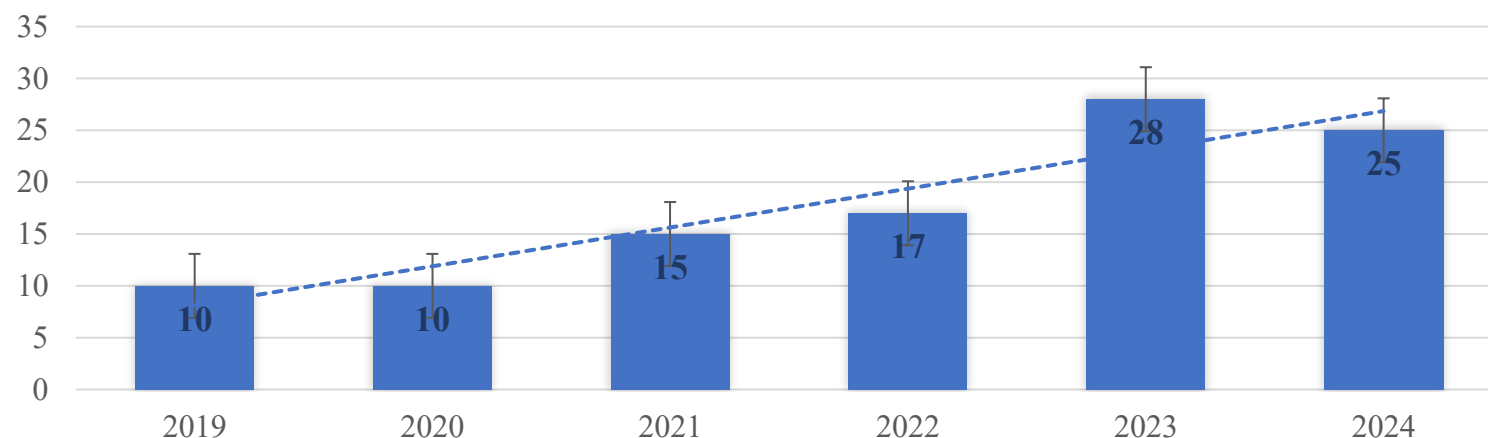

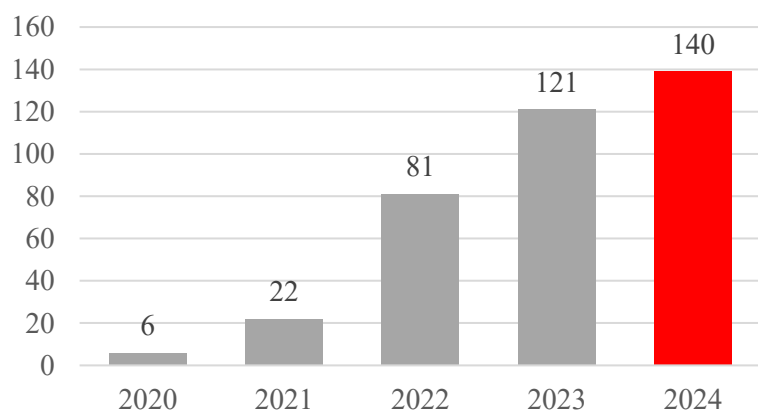

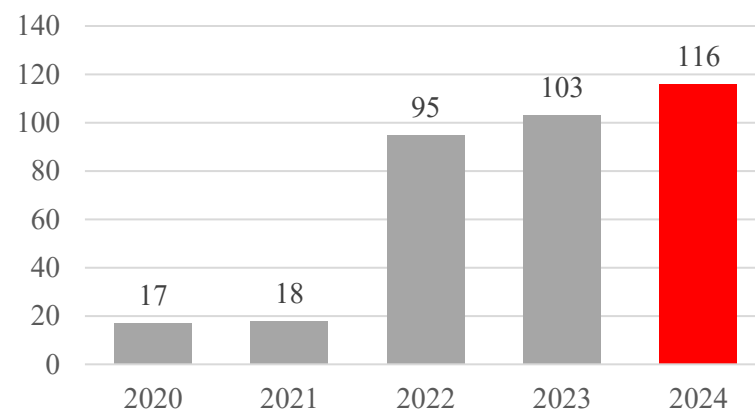

The academic trip of the students of TSUOS

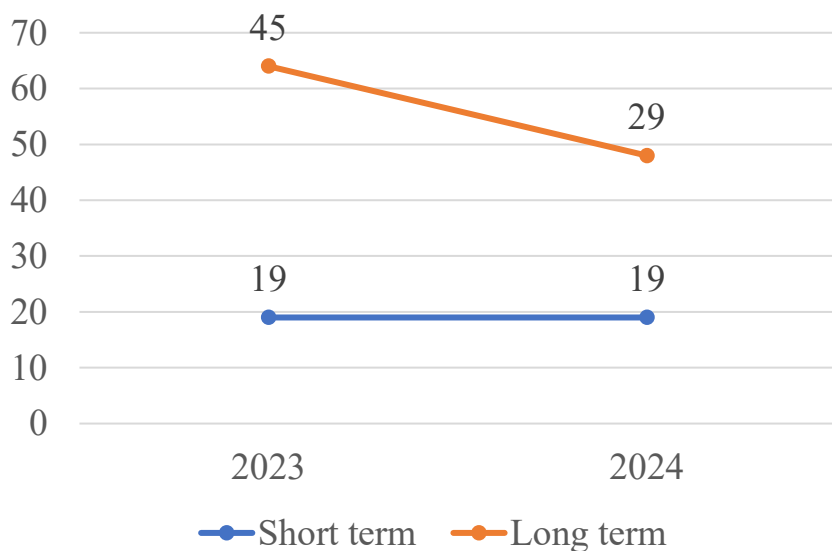

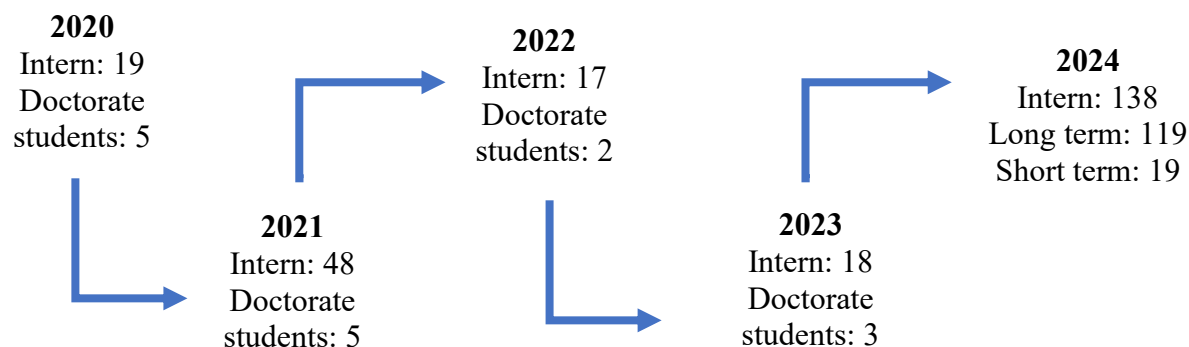
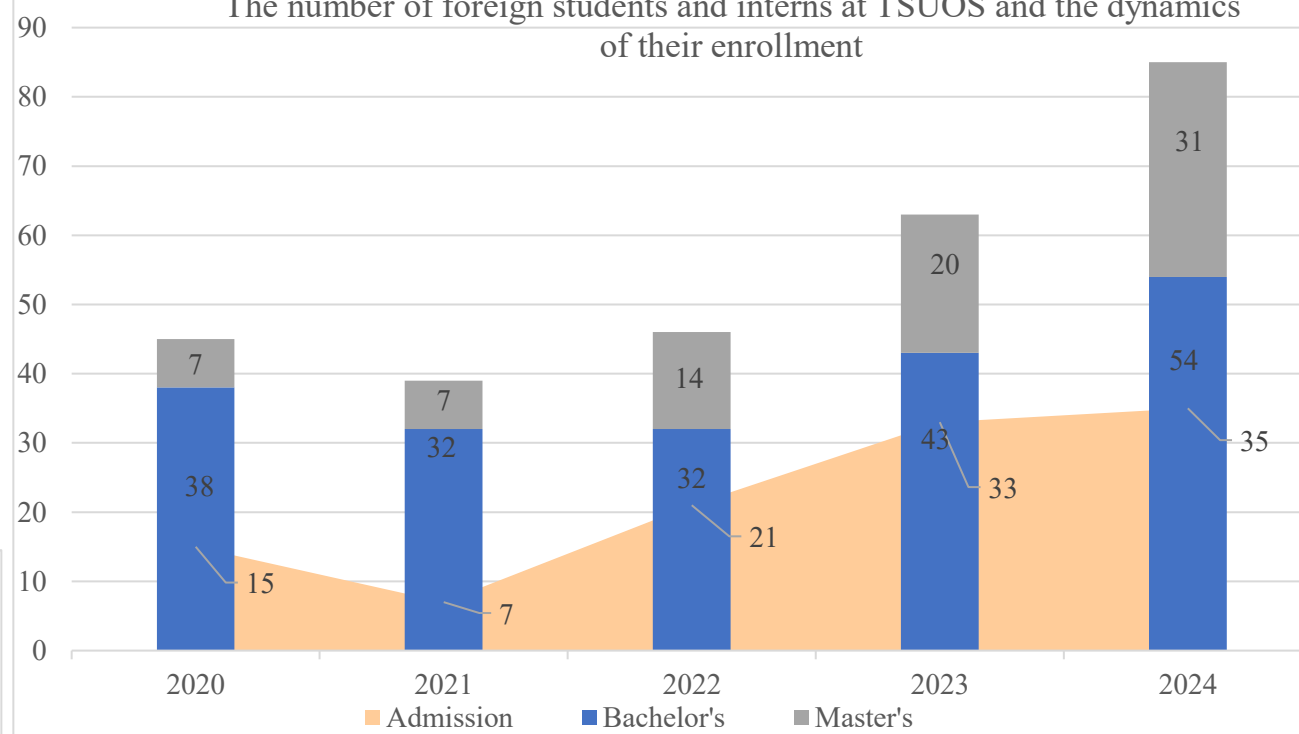

TSUOS REPRESENTATIVES

On March 19-23, 2024, the Rector of TSUOS G. Rikhsieva, who returned from a business trip to the People's Republic of China, visited [Minzu University of China](#) and had a meeting with the President of Minzu University, Prof. Guo Guangsheng. During the meeting, issues of cooperation between the two universities were discussed, and it was agreed to open a center for Central Asian studies under TSUOS.

On December 14-15, 2024, the “[7th International Forum on Humanitarian Exchange and Cooperation between Central Asia and China](#)” was held at one of the prestigious universities in Gansu Province, China — the Northwest Normal University. At the opening ceremony of the international event, Dilshoda Khodjimuratova, Head of the Strategic Development and Transformation Department at TSUOS, and Noiba Valieva, Senior Lecturer at the School of Sinology, delivered their presentations.

On September 27-28, 2024, the 3rd [Uzbekistan-Turkiye Education Forum](#) was held at Istanbul Technical University in the Republic of Türkiye. The rector of the Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies, Professor G. Rikhsieva, is participating in this prestigious international event.

In July 2024, Elyor Matchanov, Dean of the Faculty of Japanese Studies, and Marufkhodja Nadjimkhodjaev, Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Japanese Studies at TSUOS, visited Japan. During the trip, they visited one of the world's most prestigious universities – [Hiroshima University](#).

On September 27, 2024, an international forum was held at Beijing University of Foreign Languages and Culture to mark the [20th anniversary of Confucius Institutes](#). The event was recognized as a significant platform for strengthening global cooperation in the field of education.



From October 7 to 11, 2024, Professor Poshshajon Kenjaeva and Associate Professor Dilafruz Muhiddinova of TSUOS paid an official visit to the [Republic of Türkiye](#). During the visit, they visited some of the country's leading universities – Ankara, Istanbul, Hacettepe, Gazi, and Marmara – which are among the top 1000 universities in the world. In addition, PhD candidate Foziljon Rajabov conducted research using resources at the Marmara University library.

Associate Professor of the Department of Chinese Philology of TSUOS, Xasanova Feruza, participated in an official [business trip](#) to Beijing, China, as part of the official delegation of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Uzbekistan from January 20 to 27, 2024. As an associate professor at TSUOS, she took part in the “Uzbekistan Culture Days” event as an interpreter.
