

ON THE WAY TO IMPLEMENTING THE FIVE IMPORTANT INITIATIVES
Information on the work carried out at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies to
widely implement the five important initiatives put forward by the President of the Republic
of Uzbekistan

Initiative 1. Increasing young people’s interest in music, painting, literature, theatre and other forms of art, and identifying and developing their talents
In order to engage university students more extensively in Uzbek, Eastern and Western literature, as well as various fields of national art under the guidance of experienced professors and teachers, the university operates a number of creative clubs and groups, including the “Mangu Bitik” Literary and Creative Club, “Sharq Yulduzi” Theatre Studio, “Sanduvoch” Vocal and Dance Ensemble, “Dutchilar” Ensemble, and “Sharq Navolari” Choir.
The “Oriental Studies Students Festival” is held twice during each academic year.
The university organizes competitions such as “The Most Active Student of the Year,” “Student Theatre Studio,” and “Quvnoqlar va Zukkolar” (The Merry and Clever).
The “Sharq Yulduzi” Theatre Studio, consisting of students with acting and public-speaking skills, has been established and is actively functioning.
The “Sanduvoch” Ensemble, consisting of students interested in singing, playing musical instruments and dancing, has been established.
The “Mangu Bitik” Literary and Creative Club has been established with the aim of enhancing students’ artistic and aesthetic thinking, promoting national and universal human values, supporting creative students, and helping them realize their talents.
Within the framework of the “My Profession Is My Pride” project, the “Computer Literacy” Club operates in the university’s student residence.
The university has established a “Sewing Club” aimed at developing students’ creative abilities and improving their practical skills.
The “Values of My Homeland” review competition is held among students of higher education institutions.
The “Enlightenment Square” review competition is organized by the Center for Increasing the Social Activity of Students and Pupils under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation with the aim of increasing young people’s knowledge, enlightenment, scientific outlook and intellectual potential.
The “Student Theatre Studios” review festival is held among students of higher education institutions.
The Center for Increasing the Social Activity of Students and Pupils under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation organizes the republican review competition “Expert in Reforms” among teaching staff and students of educational institutions.
The “Uzbek Language — Interpreter of My Heart” review competition is held among foreign students studying at the university whose native language is not Uzbek.
In cooperation with the Writers’ Union of Uzbekistan and the Madaniyat va Ma’rifat channel, a poetry and music evening entitled “Shoir-u She’r-u Shuur...” is organized.
Initiative 2. Creating the necessary conditions for young people to demonstrate their abilities in physical education and sports

In order to promote physical fitness among university students, foster a healthy lifestyle and support their comprehensive development, students are involved in sports clubs equipped with the necessary sports facilities and equipment, taking into account their individual interests.
Mass sports competitions are organized among students in football, volleyball, basketball, chess, athletics and table tennis as part of the “Rector’s Cup” competitions.
Sports competitions are organized among young teachers and students under the motto “Sport Is the Guarantee of Health.”
Necessary conditions have been created to popularize table tennis , and a dedicated sports club has been established.
The university organizes and participates in sports competitions and projects such as the “Student League,” “Universiade,” “Talaba-Yugur,” “Oriental Studies Students Sports Festival–2025,” “Five Initiatives Olympiad,” and “Olympiad of Students of New Uzbekistan.” Sports competitions among young teachers and students are also held under the motto “Sport Is the Guarantee of Health,” along with the military-sports competition “Heirs of Amir Temur.”
An inter-faculty sports competition (spartakiada) is held at the university and in the student residence with the participation of teachers and students.

Initiative 3. Organizing the effective use of computer technologies and the Internet among the population and young people
Measures are being taken to develop students’ information analysis and digital literacy skills. Additional Wi-Fi zones are being established at the university, while student residences are being fully provided with access to the global Internet network.
Competitions in the field of computer technologies, including “Bloggers,” “Young Inventors,” and “Clipmakers,” are organized among students.
In order to provide information about university news, meetings and current issues, as well as to publish analytical articles and works by creative students of Oriental Studies, the electronic and print newspaper “News from the East” and its Telegram channel have been established.
A student video competition entitled “My Uzbekistan” is held.
The “Quest Step by Step” project is organized among students of higher education institutions.
The republican competition “Best Creative Idea” is held.
Various intellectual games are organized among students, including “Zakovat,” “DEBATE,” “Munozara,” “Historical Zakovat,” and the “Ittifoq Quiz” intellectual competition.
Within the framework of the VII Oriental Studies Students Festival , the “Orientalist Book Lover” project, the “Zakovat QUIZ” intellectual competition, and the “National Values” review competition are held.

Initiative 4. Raising the spiritual and moral awareness of young people and widely promoting a culture of reading
In order to cultivate students’ love for their Motherland, their sense of responsibility for its future and their spirit of dedication through literary works, as well as to enrich the collection of the university’s Information and Resource Center with new publications, various events are organized at faculties with the involvement of entrepreneurs and other stakeholders.
The university implements the “Sharing Enlightenment” project, aimed at engaging students in reading, increasing their level of literary literacy, and fostering patriotism and a sense of responsibility for the future of the country.

The “Young Book Reader” competition is held.
The Center for Increasing the Social Activity of Students and Pupils organizes the online competition “Young Readers League.”
The university has established the “Best Book Reader” Scholarship for students.
The university has established the “Ogahiy Scholarship” for students.
The “Followers of Navoi” competition is held among university students.
Under the motto “Travelling Across the Homeland,” cultural excursions for professors, teachers and students are organized in order to study and widely promote the ancient and rich history of our country and strengthen young people’s sense of national pride and dignity.
These excursions are organized under such themes as “The Memory of Our Ancestors Lives in Our Hearts” (including visits to the Alley of Writers and sacred sites), “Uzbekistan — A Blessed Land,” “Why We Love Uzbekistan,” and “On the Path of Development and Creation.”

Initiative 5. Ensuring employment for women
In order to increase the social activity of young people, particularly young women, and help them acquire practical professional skills, relevant action plans are developed and implemented. Existing vacancies in the areas where students permanently reside are studied, and a system is being established to involve graduating students in available employment opportunities and ensure their employment.
In cooperation with the university psychologist and the Women’s Organization, special courses entitled “Preparing Young People for Family Life” have been organized.
In cooperation with the university psychologist and tutors, the “Young Psychologists” Club has been established among students interested in psychology.
In cooperation with the university psychologist and the Women’s Committee, the “Nourishment for the Soul” Telegram channel has been launched to address psychological issues and concerns of young people and female students.
The university has established the “Qizlarjon” and “Leader Girls” clubs aimed at improving the moral and aesthetic culture and socio-political activity of female students, as well as guiding them towards professional skills and careers.
Measures have been taken to organize and improve the effectiveness of spiritual, moral and educational activities among female students residing in student residences.
A National Dress Month is held among female students under the theme “National Dress — My Pride.”
A thematic week entitled “An Educated Woman — The Mirror of Society” is held in connection with 11 February — the International Day of Women and Girls in Science.
In order to prevent family breakdowns and divorces, events are organized under the motto “You Are Responsible for Your Own Future,” with the participation of experienced teachers and psychologists.
A thematic week is held in connection with 25 November — the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women.
In cooperation with local mahallas, events are organized under the motto “We Are All Responsible for Strong Families!” aimed at strengthening families and improving the social and psychological environment in troubled families.
