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This Qualification Requirement is an official normative and methodological document developed in accordance with the "State Educational Standard of Higher Education. Basic Rules", "State Educational Standard of Higher Education. Classifier of Areas and Specialties of Higher Education", the National Qualification and Sectoral Qualification Framework (Framework) of the Republic of Uzbekistan, professional standards and proposals from personnel customers. The right to officially publish the Qualification Requirements in the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan belongs to the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovations of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

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1. General description

The Master's degree program in the specialty of literary criticism/literary studies is carried out in full-time forms of education. Training in all forms of education is organized on the basis of a credit-module system. The standard duration of the Master's program is 2 years.

1.1. Scope of application.

1.1.1. Application of the qualification requirement:

Qualification requirement 70230104 — Represents a set of requirements for all higher education institutions that train masters in the master's degree specialty of Literary Studies.

1.1.2. The main users of qualification requirements are:

management staff of the higher education organization (rector, vice-rectors, heads of academic departments, deans and heads of departments) and professors and teachers of the higher education organization responsible for the development and updating of qualification requirements, curricula and subject programs for this master's specialty, and the effective implementation of the educational process based on them, and responsible for the level of preparation of graduates within the scope of their authority; students of the higher education organization mastering the curriculum and subject programs of the master's specialty; State attestation commissions assessing the level of preparation of master's graduates; authorized state bodies for education management; bodies providing financing for higher education organizations; authorized state bodies for accreditation and quality control of the higher education system; personnel customers and employing organizations and enterprises; bachelor's degree graduates entering higher education organizations and other interested persons.

1.2. Description of professional activities

1.2.1. Areas of professional activity:

70230104 — Master's degree in Literary Studies — In higher, advanced training and retraining institutions, within the scope of the specialty, students can study Uzbek literature, the literature being studied, world literature, comparative literary studies, theory and practice of comparative literary studies, theory of literary studies, history of Uzbek literature, history of the literature being studied, world literature and folklore of the ancient period, history and theory, history of world literary studies, folklore of the peoples being studied, new literature of the country being studied, artistic

Fundamentals of analysis, methodology of literary studies, fundamentals of scientific research, philosophy of literature; teaching the Uzbek language and literature in general education, secondary specialized, vocational education institutions; conducting scientific research in scientific research centers, scientific and production associations of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan and branch scientific research institutes, production and service enterprises of various forms of ownership, state administration bodies, various forms of ownership, industrial and business organizations.

1.2.2. Objects of professional activities:

Conducting pedagogical activities in specialized subjects in higher education, retraining and advanced training, general secondary, secondary specialized, and professional educational institutions;

To carry out scientific and practical research, theoretical and practical analysis, and modeling in the field of literary studies at the Academy of Sciences, branch research institutes and centers, and higher educational institutions; to work in state and local government bodies; to organize and manage translation and administrative work in state, non-state, and private organizations; to work in the media, in the editorial offices of newspapers and journals, and in publishing houses.

1.2.3. Types of professional activities

- scientific research activities;
- spiritual and moral;
- organizational and managerial activities;
- pedagogical activity: scientific and pedagogical activity in higher, advanced training, and retraining educational institutions, as well as pedagogical activity in the system of general education, secondary specialized, and vocational education (in accordance with the established procedure);

1.2.4. Professional duties:

70230104 — In accordance with the 7th qualification level of the National Qualification Framework in the specialty of Literary Studies and the areas, objects and types of professional activities of the master, a master's degree graduate must be able to perform the following professional tasks:

In scientific research activities:

Taking into account advanced practices in relevant scientific fields, study, analyze and generalize new scientific results, scientific literature and research projects related to the specialty;

study scientific literature, scientific research projects and new scientific results relevant to professional activities;

conduct scientific and practical research, process experimental results and draw scientifically based conclusions based on them;

prepare and edit scientific articles; purposefully search and find information on the latest scientific, design, technological and operational achievements on the Internet; organize, hold and actively participate in international scientific seminars, conferences and symposiums; develop scientific projects on local and international specialty topics; develop conceptual and theoretical models of scientific problems and tasks being solved;

develop scientific reviews on the topic of the research being conducted, compile abstracts and bibliographies.

In spiritual and educational activities:

be able to plan spiritual and educational work, master the methodology of its organization, instill in the minds of students the idea of love for spiritual heritage, thirst for healthy faith, mutual kindness;

know the methods and technologies of creating immunity in students against ideological and information attacks;

conduct explanatory work on the role and influence of written spiritual heritage in the processes taking place in the context of globalization;

conduct individual conversations on issues of spiritual and moral education in neighborhoods;

reveal such high human qualities as universal values, kindness, tolerance, patriotism, and loyalty when conducting national traditions and rituals.

be able to make organizational management decisions in non-standard situations and take responsibility for these decisions;

use technical means of teaching to conduct training in the subject being taught; conduct regular self-improvement in various methods, tools, and other areas of the subject being taught and pedagogical activity as a result of independent learning and creative research; must have the ability to develop DTS, Qualification Requirements, State Requirements, and other educational and normative documents for the field of humanitarian sciences.

Providing various services:

scientific study of the history of literary studies, covering processes from an objective and impartial scientific point of view;

having accurate information on the topics studied;

carrying out methodological activities related to the use of libraries, information and resource centers, periodical press pages and archival information; being able to read and use ancient manuscripts and lithographic sources; providing paid educational services;

having the ability to provide research work and other services on the basis of state grants and economic contracts on a topic appropriate to the specialization

2. Requirements for professional competencies:

world literary studies, and literary theory; to be aware of the main stages and development trends of the history of literary studies; to master the methodology of teaching special subjects and the use of information and innovative technologies in pedagogical activities;

To understand and apply theoretical laws related to the poetics of classical poetic and prose texts in scientific activities, to acquire the skills of analyzing texts of classical literary samples; to master the methodology of scientific research in literary studies, to be able to use various methods in conducting research; to be aware of the foundations of literary studies, literary theory, literary criticism, literary terms and their theoretical foundations; to conduct scientific and practical research, process experimental results and draw scientifically based conclusions based on them, prepare and edit scientific articles, organize and conduct scientific seminars, conferences and symposiums, and develop scientific projects; to acquire the skills of studying the history of world literature, world literary studies traditional and avant-garde directions of methodology, methods and ways of approaching examples of world literature based on national artistic thinking; study of the content, essence, historical and theoretical stages of comparativism, analysis and interpretation of typological features of examples of Eastern and Western literature; an important component of comparative literary studies is a deep understanding of the foundations of translation theory, translation practice, working with text, awareness of the reality of literary texts and problems of pragmatic translation;

To have scientific information about the term "historical poetics", its sources, the history of study, literary scholars who have studied the problem, the specific relationship of historical poetics with "theoretical poetics"; problems of periodization of the history of literature of the Turkic peoples, the folklore of the Turkic peoples, the transition of ancient myths and legends, themes, heroes, plots to written literature, folklore epics and written epics, itinerant plots, variants in epics, the formation of written literature, religious and secular literature, translated literature, genres; to know the genesis of folklore, linguistic folklore, stages of development of folklore, the history of its formation, understanding the laws of historical folklore genres and their poetic characteristics, and being able to apply them in folklore research; to know the stylistic analysis methods used in the analysis of literary text categories, linguistic units representing literary text categories, and to be able to use them in their scientific and professional activities; to know innovative approaches to improving the quality and efficiency of education; to be able to study in general secondary educational institutions, relevant educational institutions of the Higher Educational Institutions and Higher Educational Institutions in the subjects provided for in the preparatory course

have the ability to conduct theoretical classes; have the ability to conduct practical and laboratory classes in the subjects provided for in the preparatory direction in general secondary educational institutions, in the relevant educational institutions of the Secondary Specialized and Vocational Education and higher educational institutions, including in educational workshops; have the ability to form and compile educational and methodological documents necessary for conducting lessons in the subjects being taught;

have the ability to develop and operate technical means of teaching to conduct classes in the subject being taught; have the ability to regularly improve oneself in the areas of

methods, tools and forms in the field of the subject being taught and pedagogical activity as a result of independent learning and creative search; have the ability to develop educational and methodological complexes for electronic (e-learning) and mobile (m-learning) teaching; understand the essence of documents and works related to professional activity in one of the studied Eastern and Western languages, know the methodology of scientific research and pedagogy and be able to use it in professional activity on a modern scientific basis; know the theoretical foundations of literary studies of the studied country, the history of its development stages, the scientific activities of literary scholars, read, analyze and scientifically interpret scientific sources related to the specialty, scientific journals, fundamental research and dissertations; classify written sources created in the studied Eastern language and determine their evolutionary language features; study the formation of the science of poetics (poetology) in the literature of the Eastern peoples, monuments of poetics and their genesis; world literary processes and their impact on the literature of the studied country; changes in prose and poetry based on literary influence; changes in artistic style in the processes of influence and interaction; the role of translation art in the development of literary relations; must have the skills and abilities to classify information on the issue of external influence on the literature being studied based on theoretical materials, to search for and systematically analyze the necessary materials to research the problems in it.

3. Requirements for practices.

Scientific and pedagogical practice is aimed at strengthening theoretical knowledge in general and specialized disciplines and combining it with practical (production) processes, and the formation of relevant practical skills, competencies, and qualifications.
