You are cordially invited to participate in the **International Scientific Conference** entitled “**Turkic Written Heritage: Intercivilizational Dialogue and the Digital Future,**” dedicated to **World Turkic Languages Family Day**, which will be held on **December 15–16, 2026**, at Tashkent State University of Oriental Studies.

The main objective of the conference is to study Turkic written monuments preserved in manuscript collections around the world from the perspectives of **history, philology, and textual studies**; strengthen digitalization in these fields; make effective use of **artificial intelligence (AI)** technologies; create electronic corpora of the vocabulary used in written monuments; and promote the written heritage of the Turkic peoples in the international academic community.

CONFERENCE THEMATIC SESSIONS:

I. Comparative-Historical Study of Turkic Written Monuments:
The language, style, and poetics of Old Turkic inscriptions.

II. Source Studies and Textual Criticism:
Problems of preparing critical editions and conducting paleographic analyses of manuscripts and epigraphic monuments.

III. Computational Linguistics and Electronic Corpora:
Experiences in creating national and historical electronic corpora of Turkic languages.

IV. Digitalization and Innovations:
Applications of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and OCR technologies in the decipherment and restoration of ancient Turkic texts.

V. Musealization and Global Integration:
Establishing international interlibrary networks for the preservation of Turkic written heritage and developing cultural tourism.

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING SCIENTIFIC PAPERS:

The paper must meet academic standards and be based on thorough analytical and scientific research.

Text format: Microsoft Word

Font: Times New Roman, 14 pt

Line spacing: 1.5

Length: 8–10 pages

Structure of the paper:

The **title of the paper** should be placed in the center of the first line, written in **uppercase letters and bold type**.

On the following line, aligned to the **right**, the author's full name, academic degree, academic title, institutional affiliation, and e-mail address should be provided.

At the beginning of the paper, a **130–140-word abstract** and **keywords** should be provided in **Uzbek and English**.

The list of **references and scholarly sources** should be provided at the end of the paper.

In-text citations should be given in square brackets, for example: **[1, p. 15]**.

NOTE:

Papers that do not meet the established academic requirements will **not be accepted**.

The conference proceedings will be published as a **separate volume** and assigned a **digital DOI ID**, with indexing in **Google Scholar and Crossref**.
